

## **DELUXE CROATIAN ISLAND CRUISE**







## TRIP OVERVIEW

Set sail along one of the most breathtakingly scenic coastlines in the world where rugged mountains cascade down into the crystalline waters. Cruise between peaceful islands and picturesque coastal cities, whilst making stops at historic Korcula, reputedly the birth place of the legendary explorer Marco Polo, lavender-scented Hvar and the idyllic forest covered isle of Mljet. On shore guest will have time on their own to explore the many fascinating sites within these enchanting locations.

## **ITINERARY & DETAILS**

This document aims to give you all the information that you require for a smooth and comfortable trip on your Croatian Island Cruise. Please take the time to read this dossier to familiarise yourself with all the aspects of our tour. It includes important information such as flight details, visa requirements and travel insurance.

## DAY 1: UK to Trogir

Depart London on your direct flight to Split, where you will be transferred to your boat, docked in the port of Trogir, for the night. This afternoon\* spend time exploring the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Diocletian's Palace, built by the Roman emperor Diocletian as a fortress in the 4th century. It now forms the centre of a bustling city.

## DAY 2: Trogir to Hvar Island B/L

Head for the island of Hvar, known to be the longest and sunniest Croatian island and a favourite with sailors for over two thousand years. Weather permitting, the cruise will stop en route for a relaxing swim off island Solta, a secluded cove, before arriving at the island's hub, Hvar Town. Spend your evening sampling its hip but laid-back restaurant scene.

## DAY 3: Hvar Island to Mljet National Park B/L/D

A highlight of the cruise, Mijet is known as Croatia's greenest island with the national park making up almost one third of the landmass. After lunch, take a local ferry to Islet Melita, a charming island in the middle of the Large Lake, to visit the former Benedictine monastery. This evening, be a guest of your captain and enjoy a three-course meal on board your vessel.

## DAY 4: Mljet National Park to Dubrovnik B/L

Journey south this morning, stopping for a swimming break at the Elafiti Islands. This afternoon, arrive in the port of the UNESCO-listed city of Dubrovnik, known as the 'Pearl of the Adriatic'. This enchanting seaside city has provided the backdrop to many feature-length films. Explore the Old Town, where all first-time visitors should begin with a walk around the magnificent medieval city walls.

## DAY 5: Dubrovnik to Korcula Island B/L

This morning head to Korcula, stopping en route in a bay off the Elafiti Islands for a leisurely swim. After lunch, cruise along to Korcula with time to discover the town and acclaimed birthplace of the explorer Marco Polo. With an impressive old fortress and quaint cobbled streets, Korcula is an idyllic place to spend the evening.

## DAY 6: Korcula Island to Brač Island B/L

Set sail along the crystal blue waters for Brac Island, stopping in one of the beautiful secluded bays of this area for swimming and sunbathing. The island landscape of Brac is dominated by a limestone relief, with numerous gullies, crevices, cavities, valleys and coves. Brač is also known for being one of the largest islands in the entire Adriatic Sea.

## DAY 7: Brač Island to Trogir B/L

Depart from the island of Brač, stopping for a swim in a bay on the island of Čiovo. Continue to Trogir, a small picturesque town with lot of secrets situated on an island by the Adriatic Sea. Discover the beautiful masterpieces of famous sculptors such as the magnificent Cathedral's portal of master Radovan and the reliefs of master Niccolo di Giovanni Fiorentino. You can find many shops, bars and restaurants throughout this medieval town, a perfect way to spend your final evening before retiring to the boat.

## DAY 8: Trogir to UK or extension B

After breakfast on board the boat, disembark and transfer to the airport for your flight back to the UK or continue on to your extension.



## WHAT TO PACK

- Warm clothes in case of cold weather
- Insect repellant
- Suncream and a hat with a big brim for sunny days
- Comfortable shoes such as trainers
- Sunglasses and plastic bags
- Towel and swimsuit

- Snorkel, for off shore stops
- Ruck sack or light bag per person
- Personal toiletries and first aid kit
- Travel plug adapter the electricity supply on board the boat is 220 V.
  You will need a 2 round pin plug adapter.



## WHAT YOU NEED FOR YOUR TOUR

#### Visas

A visa is not required for your trip to Croatia. Further advice should be sought from the applicable tourist authority for other nationalities and for general queries. We strongly advise you check your destinations' Tourist Board or Embassy for the most up-to-date guidelines regarding passport validity.

#### Insurance

We strongly recommend that you and all members of your party are suitably insured as soon as you book your holiday. It is a condition of booking that you must have suitable travel insurance. It is important that you purchase travel insurance that suitably covers your participation in whatever activities you may undertake at the time that you make your booking. To assist you with this, we have arranged travel insurance in partnership with Holiday Extras. To arrange your travel insurance with Holiday Extras, please call 0800 781 4237 and quote 'WK830' for preferential rates. Please ensure you provide us with the name of your insurer, policy number and their 24 hour emergency contact number as soon as possible. Mercury Holidays will not be liable for any costs incurred by you due to your failure to take out suitable travel insurance from the date of booking.

#### **Tour Guides**

Airport transfers will be with an English-speaking driver and you will have assistance on embarkation and disembarkation. On board the crew speak English as well as other languages and will give information and assistance to all international passengers. For your added reassurance your driver will give you a welcome letter on arrival, containing contact details and the emergency phone number of our local agent Perfecta Travel, should you need it.

#### Tipping

It is customary to tip approximately  $\Sigma 20.00$  (200KN) per person for the duration of your cruise. You may tip at the end of the cruise, at check-out. This is shared between all staff members on board the cruise. Tips are accepted in any currency, however it is asked that if you do not tip in the local currency that you only pay in notes as coins cannot be exchanged.

#### **Health and Vaccinations**

It is your responsibility to check any health and vaccination requirements applicable to your booked arrangements. We can only provide general information about this. Health and hygiene facilities and disease risks vary from country to country. You should take health advice about your own needs as

early as possible and in good time before your departure. Sources of information include; www.fco.gov.uk, www.travelhealthpro.org.uk, www.hpa.org.uk, your General Practitioner or a specialist clinic.

#### **Physical Accessibility**

This tour is accessible to most people with an average level of fitness. It involves some climbing of steep steps, and getting on and off boats. This tour is not suitable for anyone with walking difficulties.

#### **Group Size**

The maximum number of passengers on your cruise will be 40 passengers. If in the unlikely event the tour does not go ahead then you may be asked to change to a different date. A full refund will be made available to your should this alternative not be suitable.

## **Currency Exchange**

The currency in Croatia is the Croatian Kuna, We recommend that you exchange your currency before you leave the UK, however cash machines are available in all the major cities to withdraw money in the local currency.

#### **Personal Expenses**

You will need to take some extra money with you to cover any dinners where these are not mentioned on your itinerary and personal purchases, such as souvenirs, extra drinks and snacks. Approximately £200-£300 per person will be sufficient for the duration of the tour. Should you wish to pay for any onboard purchases by card, please inform a crew member of this at the beginning of your cruise. If this is not mentioned, only payment by cash will be accepted. IMPORTANT - Embarkation Tax

Am embarkation tax of €21 per person must be paid in cash on arrival to your vessel.

#### **Itinerary Changes**

The order of events and sightseeing may vary according to local conditions or for operational purposes. For this reason, we have indicated approximate times only. Your local guide will inform you of any schedule changes as they are informed of them. Some road construction and/or weather conditions may lengthen the driving times. Our intention is to adhere to the day-to-day itinerary as printed; however order of events and sightseeing may vary according to local conditions.

## **FLIGHT INFORMATION**

Your flight is to Split International Airport with Norwegian Airlines (D8), departing from London Gatwick South Terminal.

IMPORTANT: Final flight details will be confirmed on your e-ticket and final documentation which will be sent to you approximately 10 days before departure.

## **Baggage Allowance**

Each passenger is entitled to 20KG of hold luggage plus 1 item of hand luggage not exceeding in size and 1 personal item such as a handbag, briefcase or laptop case. Weight restrictions will be finalized on E-ticket receipt. Should you wish to take additional luggage you will need to pay extra at check – in. Check-In should be at least 3 hours before departure.

Occasionally suitcases can be removed by the airport staff from the baggage carousel and placed in the baggage reclaim office, should you not see your luggage on the carousel, please report to the baggage reclaim office.





Weather can vary quite considerably throughout the year, so please familiarise yourself with the climate charts below.








